The Storm Trysail Foundation is unique. We operate in two basic modes:

- **Grant Programs**: As a 501(c)(3), we make grants to organizations whose operations fit with our Mission (see back of this page). Most of the public cannot access sailing through yacht clubs, therefore our outreach through our Grant program (initiated by Bo and Edie Lycke in honor of Edward du Moulin) now supports 15 community sailing groups and Sea Scout "ships". Storm Trysail members and friends help identify effective community sailing organizations around the country. STF provides support with an assigned liaison, volunteer coaches, educational opportunities (attending SAS seminars and accessing our on-line resources), and cash grants which will total \$45,000 in 2023.
- Events: We proactively organize, underwrite, and partner with other organizations. Our 2023 Storm Trysail SAS Seminars were partnered/hosted with SUNY and Maine Maritime Colleges and the following yacht clubs: Larchmont, Austin, Severn Sailing, Eastern, Raritan Bay, Buffalo, and Chicago. The Intercollegiate Offshore Regatta was partnered between Storm Trysail and Larchmont. We underwrote and provided volunteers and equipment for the U.S. Sailing National Man Overboard Evaluation Trials.

Thought Leader: The huge number of events provides Storm Trysail with the unique opportunity to develop Leadership Training and new techniques for Man Overboard Recovery and Damage Control. The world's leading offshore racing publication, *Seahorse Magazine*, just published a three part series (August, September, October) on our MOB practices.
